

TECHNICAL RIDER

STAGE

Stage should be at least 4m deep, 6m wide and free clearance at least 3m from stage. Drum riser 2x3m is a nice addition with some reasonable height. There should be possibility to hang Free Spirit backdrop sized 5m wide, 3m tall. Electricity for backline must be provided for all the instruments and a few extras to front of stage for pedalboards.

FOH

We will usually bring our own digital console (Soundcraft Si Performer 1) and stage box. We are more than happy to use house provided Cat5 cable (NOT crossover, max 75m) if available, or maybe even two to be redundant. Otherwise we will use our own cabling. We can connect to house system either from FOH or stage, with AES or analog, whatever is more convenient. Please inform us in advance if there is need for extra feed, such as fill matrixes, aux subs etc.

FOH position should be centered to the main PA. Any walls must be avoided as well as balcony lids and such. There should be enough room for rack sized console and tabletop rack with other gear. Nice working height would be somewhere around 90cm from floor. Five free electric outlets are also needed at FOH and one at the stage for stage box.

PA

PA system must be made by a renowned manufacturer such as L-Acoustics, d&b audiotechnik, Nexo, etc. Line arrays are preferred, if it is proven to be good choice for the venue. There should be enough headroom for a rock show without distortion, with even SPL distribution and flat frequency responce to whole audience. Frontfills must be provided if the main PA doesn't reach the front row. There must be a qualified system technician present during the whole sound check and gig.

MON

Free Spirit uses In-Ear-Monitoring and they are fed from FOH via stage box. On large stages we would like to have an option to use sidefills as a support, if possible.

MICS, STANDS, ETC.

We will bring our own mics and direct boxes. We still need from the venue all the stage multicores (2x 12/4ch,1x 6ch), mic and electricity cabling and some microphone stands. All the mentioned must be in perfect working condition. Check out the channel list to make sure you have them all.

LIGHT

All the lighting shall be provided by venue. We appreciate very much if there is a decent amount of intelligent lighting fixtures for a rock show, as well as nice frontlight and even water based haze. Light operator is also needed with good taste and sense of drama.

VSB = Very Short Boom, SB = Short Boom, TB = Tall Boom. Multicores; M1 to drum set, M2 to keyboards, M3 to front of stage. Electricity needs to be provided to Gtr L, Keys, DRs, Bass, Gtr R and to the stage front for the pedalboards.
